This is an 11% increase from 2012 but accounting for the week we were closed for the NABC it is closer to 8.4%. Still nice growth considering the ACBL average was 2%. Night games are decreasing.

MENTORING GAME

This was a unit responsibility, which Judy Knox has been handling. Since this is a Club matter and Judy is no longer a club officer, we will officially appoint her to run this program. In an effort to both provide intermediate players (under 2000 points) with mentors and also to boost the Thursday game, the 5th Thursday is designated as a "potluck" partnership game where players with 2000+ points will be randomly paired with those with under 2000. There are 5th Fridays in May, July, and October. Ilene, Judy, and Susan agree to spearhead this project.

CPR
