Driving Times to New Club

Many members have asked about driving times and routes to the new club at 8180 Sedgwick Way. Here are average driving times and best routes according to Google Maps:

FROM	TIME	ROUTE(S)
Downtown/Harbertown	30-37 min.	I-240 or I-40 to 385
Midtown	25-32 min.	I-240 to 385
East Memphis (Highland to Mt. Moriah)	18-25 min.	Poplar to I-240 to 385 <i>or</i> Quince to Ridgeway to 385 <i>or</i> Park to Poplar Pike
East Memphis (Mendenhall to Ridgeway)	12-22 min.	I-240 to 385 <i>or</i> Kirby to Poplar Pike
Bartlett	25-35 min.	I-240 to 385 <i>or</i> I-240 to Walnut Grove/ Humphries to Kirby to Poplar Pike <i>or</i> I-177 to Germantown Pkwy
ACBL HQ, Horn Lake	25-35 min.	I-55 to I-240 to 385 <i>or</i> E. Shelby <i>or</i> Goodman to 385

From 385, take the Winchester exit to Hack's Cross Road north (or you can take the Hack's Cross exit). Continue on Hack's Cross past Tournament Drive to Sedgwick Way (First right after Tournament Drive).

From Poplar Pike, go past Pickering Center to Hack's Cross Road, right on Hack's Cross, left on Sedgwick Way. The new club is less than five minutes from Pickering Center.

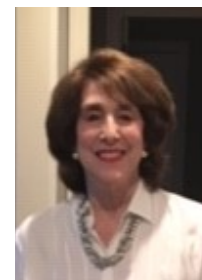
